Fairfield Battery Energy Storage Project for up to 49.9MW, on Land at Fairfield, Inverurie, AB51 5BL

## Dear Members,

I am writing to you regarding Green Switch Capital Ltd's proposal to develop a battery energy storage site, on Land at Fairfield, Inverurie, AB51 5BL. A Proposal of Application Notice (ref: ENQ/2024/1599) was resubmitted to Aberdeenshire Council on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2025.

The first public consultation event was held on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2024, and the second public consultation event was held on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2025 at the Meikle Warte Village Hall, Meikle Wartle, AB51 5AA. Additionally, the Applicant has also engaged directly with neighbouring properties close to the site. The Applicant will hold a third public consultation event on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2025 at the Meikle Warte Village Hall, Meikle Wartle, AB51 5AA.
